

## HINDU ADOPTION AND MAINTENANCE ACT

This Act deals with only two aspects relating to Hindus,

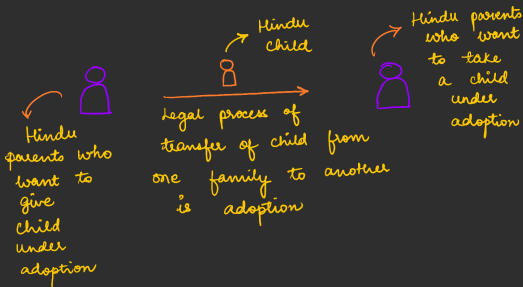
### I. Hindu Adoption

### II. Hindu Maintenance

- \* Definition of 'Hindu' is the same as in the case of Hindu Marriage Act
- \* Definition of maintenance remains the same as well. However, clear cut definition is provided under Section 3(b) of HAMA.
- \* Maintenance is available to a lot more parties under Hindu Adoptions and Maintenance Act in comparison to Hindu Marriage Act.

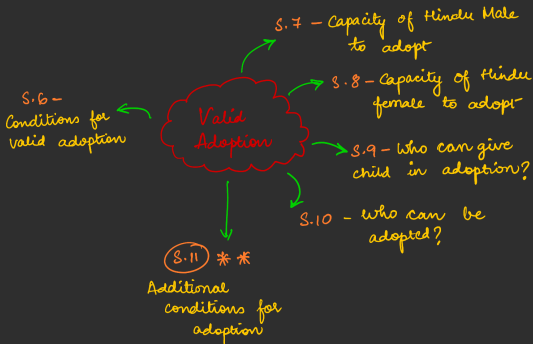
## HINDU ADOPTION



### Effects of Valid Adoption

- 1) Child stops being connected with the parents of old family and new bonds and relationships are formed with new family;
- 2) If adoption is void, then no new bonds are formed with new family.
- 3) Post 1956, adoption among Hindus will be valid only if done as per conditions under HAMA.

## What is VALID ADOPTION?



### Section 6

↳ all parties must have legal capacity to adopt/give in adoption

Section 7 → Single Hindu male can adopt either son or daughter

→ Consent of wife/wives is necessary for valid adoption

Section 8 → Single Hindu woman can adopt either son or daughter

→ Consent of husband is necessary for valid adoption

Section 9 → only three people can give child in adoption

1. Mother
  2. Father
  3. Guardian
- } If both are alive, then consent of both is needed
- on death of both parents, guardian can give child in adoption with court permission

Section 10 → who can be adopted?

- 1) Girl or Boy both can be adopted
- 2) Must be Hindu
- 3) Should NOT be married
- 4) Age NOT more than 15 years

Section 11 → Additional Conditions for Valid Adoption

Condition 1

Cannot take boy in adoption if you already

have Hindu son, grandson, great grandson alive



BOY

21 years gap



MOTHER

Condition 3

Age gap of 21 years needed between boy and adoptive mother

Condition 2



GIRL

21 years gap



FATHER

Cannot take girl in adoption if you already have Hindu daughter or grand daughter alive

Condition 4

Age gap of 21 years needed between daughter and adoptive father

Condition 5

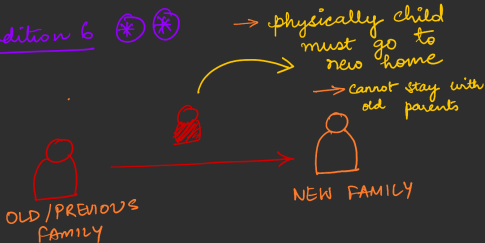


Parents giving child



Same child cannot be adopted by simultaneously by different parents

\* \* DATTA HOMAM is not essential for valid adoption

## Section 14 — who is adoptive mother?

- (1) Man already married and then adopted a child, **wife is adoptive mother**
- (2) Man has more than one wife, and he adopts a child,  
FIRST WIFE / SENIOR WIFE — **adoptive mother**  
OTHER WIVES — **Step mother**
- (3) Man adopts child, then he marries. The new wife is **STEP MOTHER, NOT ADOPTIVE MOTHER.**

(4) Woman adopts child, then she marries.  
The new husband is **STEP FATHER**,  
**NOT ADOPTIVE FATHER.**

### Section 15

Valid adoption cannot be cancelled
